



## 2015 Hansa Grand Prix Event Invitation.

Carsington Sailability extends a warm and friendly invitation to all Hansa Class sailors to participate in the Hansa Grand Prix Event to be held at Carsington Sailing Club, Carsington Water, Ashbourne Derbyshire, on the 13 and 14 June 2015. The event will be organised by Carsington Sailability which has successfully hosted annual TT events over a number of years in the past. Carsington Sailability is an integral part of Carsington Sailing Club which was opened in 1992 by HRH Queen Elizabeth II. The Sailability group is supported by and is considered to be a valued element of Carsington Sailing Club. The club has an available sailing area of approx 1.5 sq km, has excellent accessibility to the clubhouse, jetties and shore. There are two hoists available for transfers.

The Notice of Race will be posted on the HCA(UK) website along with details of available accommodation local to the venue, including those suitable for wheelchair users. Participants should be aware there is no camping allowed on the venue site. Those wishing to deliver boats/ trailers on Friday 12 June should advise the sailing club office Tel No: 01629 540609 prior to arrival.

To ensure that the organisers have sufficient notice of numbers attending it is requested that entry forms are returned as soon as possible after the Notice of Race is published. Entries received after the 30 May 2015 will attract a higher entry fee.

The Galley will be open for the purchase of food and drinks during the event.

A dinner will be held after sailing on Saturday 13 June after which there will be time to circulate around fellow competitors to reflect on the days sailing. The Galley will provide a two course menu with a selection of main and desert at a cost of £9.00 per head. A bar service will be available.
