

# The Access Travelers Trophy 2003

## Final Results

The Access Dinghy Association have planning another exciting series of races for all you Access Dinghy sailors who like to travel to other clubs in 2003.

In the Travellers Trophy (TT) we have a total of **nine events** of which **five will count**, this will keep the contest achievable to those who cannot make it to them all.

Once again the Carsington TT will, in addition to being a TT, race for the " Duke of Devonshire Trophy".

Results are awarded on a lowest points wins basis.

Points are awarded as follows;

- One point for 1st place, two points for 2nd place etc.
- Rtd stands for retired and denotes Sailors who start the race but do not finish. These will be awarded one point for each boat in the race.
- NCS stands for sailed but did not cross the start line. These will be awarded one point for each boat in the race plus 1 extra point
- DNS stands for did not start and denotes Sailors who have started at least one race in the series but not sailed at this particular event. These will be awarded one point for each boat in their category (i.e. 2.3 or 303 ) in the series up to and including the Tideway event plus 1 extra point. **Note: DNS points will be calculated after the Tideway event as it is only then that we know the total number of boats that started up to then.**
- Each Sailors best five results count. other results are discarded.
- In the event of two Sailors having the same points the Sailor with most 1st places will win. If after taking this into account a draw still exists then the sailor with the lowest last discarded result will win. This will be applied through all the discarded results. If after taking this into account a draw still exists then the Sailor who scored the latest first or subsequent highest place in the series will win.

## Access Travellers Trophy 2003 Ben Ainslie Team Trophy

For results to qualify for inclusion towards the team trophy the Helm must have sailed at least five events in the series.

A team is made up of each Clubs best three sailors/boats overall series results across the following categories: **Access 2.3**, **Access 2.3 servo assisted**, **Access 303 wide**, **Access 303 single**.

In the event of two clubs having the same number of points the club with the best fourth members result will win. This will be applied through all the clubs qualifying sailors and results until the tie is broken. If after this a tie still exists the club with the most first places will win. This will be applied through all the clubs qualifying sailors and results until the tie is broken. If after all this has been applied a tie still exists the above tie breaking rules will be applied to the results of the Clubs non-qualifying sailors until the tie is broken.
